Historic Preservation Update:

Mr. Long gave an update about the W3R signs. He stated that he and Mr. Berbit still need to draft the resolution to present to the Village Board with costs to produce and get permission to install the signs for Local, County and State roads. Mr. Long will advise when proposal is drafted. Mr. Long has a quote for costs for each sign. Mr. Long also mentioned that he had been told that the National Park Service has changed the official signage for the W3R since the HPPC approved its design for the signs. He will confirm if that is the case with Jenna Burnett, the regional rep.

Discussion moved on to the historic map. Chairperson Levin advised that HPPC revisions and recommendations had been submitted to Jonathan Lockman, who is currently working on revising the map.
