VILLAGE OF MONTEBELLO LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2022 A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 143 SIGNS, TO REQUIRE ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEXT AND CHARACTERS TO AID IN THE DISPATCH OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

Be it enacted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Montebello by authority of Article 7 of the Village Law and Article 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, as follows:

All other language shown is to remain unchanged. The symbol "****" indicates portions of the Code to remain unchanged, which are not shown here for brevity.)

Section 1: Legislative findings and intent. The Village Board of the Village of Montebello hereby finds and declares:

Currently the Village of Montebello has extensive standards for signs, found in Chapter 143, Signs of the Village Code. This local law will add a requirement for signs to contain enough English language characters and text so that in case of emergency, passersby and emergency services personnel who speak English as their primary language, may readily identify the property.

Section 2: Amend Chapter 143, Signs, by adding the following standard to the list of additional sign standards found in §143-10, as follows:

§ 143-10 Additional sign standards.

* * * * * *

M. Signs shall contain English language characters and text to the extent necessary for public safety and/or to aid in the dispatch of emergency services.

Section 2: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
